

***What information do my legal, financial and tax advisors require?***

It is vital that the legal name of the BC Lymphedema Association (BCLA) be specified in your will or when you name BC Lymphedema Association as your beneficiary. The official name is “*British Columbia Lymphedema Association*”.

***What is the BN/Tax registration number for BC Lymphedema Association?***

828294926 RR0001. Your legal, financial and tax advisors will need to know this.

***How will my legacy gift be acknowledged?***

Upon receipt of a gift, your estate will be issued a tax receipt. With your permission, we’ll notify BC Lymphedema Association members of your bequest in our BCLA newsletter.

***Will any third parties receive compensation?***

BCLA will not compensate, whether through commissions, finder’s fees or other means, any third party for directing a legacy gift or donor to the BC Lymphedema Association.

***What happens if BCLA were to fold?***

As stated in the BCLA Bylaws, all remaining funds, after payment of all liabilities, from the Association would be sent to a recognized charitable organization or educational cause designated by the members of the Association.
